CRITERIA FOR TEXAS HALL OF FAME AWARD

This award recognizes the body of work of an individual in the field of addictions counseling, and is awarded based on the many facets of their contributions over an extended period of time, the varied scope of services provided, and the populations these services reached.

The Nominee must have a minimum of ten years of experience in the field and as a member of TAAP, and has provided significant contributions to the profession and the TAAP organization.

This award is not presented every year but instead when a worthy candidate is presented that meets the full spirit of the award.

Please complete the questions below and submit them along with all of the supporting documentation. Incomplete nomination packets will NOT be considered. All nominees must be current members of TAAP.

Procedure: Individual portfolios containing supporting documentation and completed nomination form *must be submitted to Keith Liles/ Credentials and Awards Committee no later than June 12, 2009.* Please ensure that the following questions/information has been included:

1. Nominee's name, certification(s) and license(s) held and which award you are nominating them for.
2. TAAP Chapter, person, group or agency submitting the nomination
3. List work history; particularly direct field experience in a counseling relationship with clients.
4. List awards and/or recognitions awarded to nominee by civic, fraternal, legal, and religious organizations for community service.
5. List awards, accomplishments and achievements from other health service professionals.
6. List involvement in TAAP/TCBAP; specify type and extent of service (i.e., local, state or national).
7. List publication of papers, public presentations and/or teaching accomplishments.
8. List outstanding service in counseling citizens disabled by substance abuse (an emphasis area in award consideration).
9. Indicate nominee's formal education (although important, this is not an emphasis area).
10. Document all claims where possible.
